

# EL Student Rights

- Students have the right to receive language assistance services.
- Students have the right to participate equally in the standard instructional program.
- Students have the right to English language programs that are sufficiently funded and effectively implemented. This includes highly qualified teachers and appropriate instructional materials.
- Students have the right to receive grade-level curricula so they can meet promotion and graduation requirements.
- Schools may not segregate students on the basis of national origin or EL status.
- EL students with disabilities have the right to receive both language assistance services and disability related services.
