

# All Parents Have the Right to...

- To examine the textbook, curriculum, and supplemental material used in their child's classroom.
- To receive any of their child's records within ten days of request.
- To be notified when their child receives medical services.
- To be notified if criminal action has been committed against or by their child.
- To be notified if law enforcement personnel questions their child, except in cases where the parent has been accused of abusing the child.
- To be notified if the child has been taken or removed from campus without parental consent.
- That a child will not be discriminated against for religious beliefs.
- To receive information about all required fees, what purpose the fees serve, and a description of how to address economic hardships.
- To receive in writing each year a description of the school's required uniform for students.
- To be informed if their child is failing and to request an in-person meeting with the child's teacher or the school leader to discuss any resources and strategies to support the child's academic improvement.
